The open house is scheduled for February 10th at the Black Bear Resort Hotel, Port McNeill, from 4 pm to 8 pm.

Advertisements have also been placed in regional newspapers for late January and early February reminding of the date and time.

We will have staff available to talk about our applications, their locations and operational activities. There is an existing Grieg salmon farm near Turnour Island within the territory of the Tlowitsis Tribe, who have indicated their support.

In addition to the attending Grieg Seafood staff there will representatives from both Fisheries and Oceans Canada and the Province of BC.
